Subject: Certification of the March 5, 2024 Consolidated General Municipal Election Results

SUMMARY

At the March 5, 2024, Consolidated General Municipal Election the voters of the City of San Dimas voted to seat a Mayor at large and one Councilmember each for Districts 1 and 3.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council:

- Adopt Resolution 2024-17, A Resolution declaring the results and other such matters of the March 5, 2024, Consolidated General Municipal Election as provided by law.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact for the recommended action.

BACKGROUND

On October 10, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution 2023-61 calling and giving notice of the March 5, 2024, Consolidated General Municipal Election for Mayor and 1 City Councilmember each for Districts 1 and 3.

California Elections Code §10262(b) provides in a consolidated election, that the City elections official, upon receipt of the results of the election from the Registrar of Voters, shall certify the results to the governing body, no later than the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting following the 28-day canvass of the returns. Based on Elections Code §10263, before installing new officers, the City Council shall adopt a resolution reciting the facts of the election and declare elected the persons for whom the highest numbers of votes were cast for each office.

Additionally, California Elections Code §10265 directs the elections official shall immediately sign and deliver to each person elected a certificate of election and administer to each person elected the oath of office prescribed in the California Constitution.


ALTERNATIVES
